Hello, Parents!

I'm glad to see quite a few of you are logging-on to the Parent Portal! I hope you're finding this a useful tool and we greatly welcome any and all comments and feedback regarding how we can make it even more useful for you and your students.

Did you know you can sign-up for email notifications in the Parent Portal? After logging-in, click on the "Email Notification" icon in the top row of icons. You can select to receive automated emails from the PowerSchool server regarding:

- summaries of current grades and attendance
- detailed reports showing all assignment scores for each class
- detailed reports of attendance
- school announcements, lunch balance alerts (will only be sent when a student is low on funds)

And you can elect to receive any/all of these notifications once a week, once every two weeks, once a month, or even daily if you prefer. Check it out today!
